

Prof. Dr. Michael Gregor Kölch is the Medical Director of the Departments of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry of Vivantes Hospitals in Berlin. He was Deputy Medical Director of the Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry of the University Hospital Ulm (Germany) and is still a research group leader at this department.

He completed his trainee in child and adolescent psychiatry at Charité Berlin and University Hospital Ulm.

He mainly focuses on depressive and affective disorders in childhood and adolescence, psychopharmacotherapy of children and adolescents, conduct disorder and youth welfare services, high-risk populations for psychiatric disorders such as children of mentally ill parents, as well as on ethics in medical treatment of children and adolescents.
